PULPIT MINISTER: NATHAN JORGENSON

"Am I my brother's keeper?" Cain didn't actually want that question answered. He was just trying to distract God from the fact he had killed his brother. But it is a good question. In the Lord's church, do I have a role as my brother in Christ's keeper? The 33 one another passages in the NT would seem to say the answer is a resounding yes! In Acts 2, we read that one of the four pillars of the church was fellowship. Their relationships with one another carried the same value as studying the doctrine, prayer, and taking the Lord's Supper. Certainly, the church's message is Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. But Jesus told His disciples that the God-given tool they were being given to declare the truth about the Savior resided in their fellowship with one another: A new command I give you, to love one another. By this all men may know that you are my disciples if you love one another. (John 13:34-35) We all have a role to play in God's family: caring for one another, forgiving one another, bearing one another's burdens, etc. I pray that in 2024, we may each take up our part, be the people God can make us, and show the world the Savior who came and gave His life for them.

BANFORD HOUSE : AL MORNINGSTAR The food pantry served **4,904** people during 2023. 54,740 pounds of food was distributed and purchased from NWA Food Bank at an average cost of 4.7 cents per pound. This ministry is possible because of the volunteers! Arkansas bases the value of a volunteer hour at \$29.95. This equates to over \$30,000 for the 1,050 volunteer hours!

Over 25% of the budgeted amount has been checks designated for Banford House. We encourage members to feel comfortable utilizing the Banford House to help with their food budget or to be aware of the people in our lives that could be helped with food. Several members have availed themselves or their neighbors of this source of free food. This ministry is one of the several mentioned by Jesus in Matthew 25. Our ministry will be hearing from the King "I tell you the truth, just as you did it for one of the least of these brothers or sisters of mine, you did it for me."
