MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: THE BANFORD HOUSE

First Quarter of 2024 Report for the Banford House Food Pantry - Al Morningstar

The food pantry served an average of 33 households, or 80 people weekly, this quarter. We are pleased to have more of our members stopping to get food we have available before going to the grocery store to get items we do not have. This helps offset the increasing prices we are all experiencing in food costs.

This ministry is only possible because of the volunteers. In the past three months, we have had 17 volunteers, 11 of whom have helped each month. We are also very appreciative of the funds designated to supplement the regular budget.

We continue to encourage members to feel comfortable using the Banford House to help with their own food budgets or to be aware of the people in our lives that could be helped with food. Jesus in Matthew 25 says "For I was hungry and you gave me food, ... I tell you the truth, just as you did it for one of the least of these brothers or sisters of mine, you did it for me "
