MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: CHILDREN'S HOME

Mount Comfort has been a supporter of this ministry for as long as I can remember, but many newer members may not be familiar with this work. Children's Home is a faith-based, Christ-centered organization that helps in residential education, foster care, and adoptive care of children who have no family, or whose parents cannot give them the proper care they need.

The program began in 1955 under the direction of the 7th and Mueller Church of Christ in Paragould, AR. They added a foster care program a few years ago which is located in Searcy, AR. This residential care program serves children ages 11-16. There are 10 houseparent couples. Education is provided on campus at the Experiential Learning Academy which prepares the children for success when reunifying with family or transitioning into adulthood.

Mount Comfort supports this ministry by budgeted monthly giving as well as participation in the annual "Change for Children" coin can program. I encourage you to pick up a coin can which will soon be available in the lobby and help support this much needed work.
