ELDER SPOTLIGHT: MIKE HUDDLESTON

Rhythm is very important in life. A good definition of rhythm is "a strong regular, repeated, pattern of action, movement, tempo, time or pace." Rhythm is very important in nature, in our bodies, in music, in running, and in the operation of the universe. Solomon talked about the rhythm of nature in Ecc 1. Studies of centenarians (those that live to be a hundred or more) showed a common trait of a regular rhythm of repeated routines in their lives. Just as rhythm is important for physical health and longevity, it is just as important for our spiritual health and longevity. Deut 6:6-9 talks about making the life giving words of God a part of our regular rhythm of life. If we do, long life is promised in verse two. Moses tells the Israelites to talk about them, teach their children when they sit down at home, when they walk along the road, when they lie down and when they get up. He talks about tying them to their hands, foreheads and writing them on the doorframes and gates of their houses. In other words, habitually keep the words of God before you. Make them a rhythm in our life. This just as important in our prayer lives as well. You might remember the movie "The Boys in the Boat" about an Olympic rowing team. Rhythm was extremely important for the team. They worked at it fiercely until they developed just the right rhythm. So, you got rhythm?
