WALK FOR WATER

We will be hosting our first ever Walk4Water event in March. Walk4Water is a ministry of Healing Hands International, a faith-based nonprofit that has drilled more than 1,600 wells in 25 countries to date, providing clean water to remote communities. Walk4Water is a fundraising event in which walkers gather donations to help fund new wells and then get together to walk to promote awareness of this need. Donations can be made by cash or check on the day of the walk or by credit card online.

Mount Comfort's Walk4Water event will take place on Saturday, March 14 at Wilson Park in Fayetteville. Our walk will be approximately 4 miles long, which represents the average distance that people walk to get water. You do not have to walk at all, or you can walk any distance that you are comfortable with. Registration will start at 8:30 AM and the walk will begin at 9:00 AM. Participants may spontaneously show up on the day of the walk, but pre-registration is encouraged so that we can have an adequate amount of water, snacks, and supplies available.
